Morning Offering

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of May, I offer you my prayers, works, joys, and sufferings of this day for all the intentions of your Sacred Heart, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world, in thanksgiving for your favors, in reparation for my sins, and for all the intentions of my relatives and friends, and in particular for the intentions of the Holy Father. Amen.

The Precepts of the Church

- You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation, and rest from servile labor..
- 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
- 3. Your shall receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter Season.
- 4. You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- 5. You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.

Holy Days of Obligation in the United States

- 1. All Sundays of the year.
- 2. January 1: Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.
- 3. Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter: Solemnity of the Ascension.
- 4. August 15: Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
- 5. November 1: Solemnity of All Saints.
- 6. December 8: Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
- 7. December 25: Solemnity of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Reading Holy Scripture
